<u>WORKDAY:</u> Eight (8) consecutive hours between 6:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding a 30 minute lunch period. The Employer may implement a Four-Tens (4x10) shift, in accordance with Section 3.01.

OVERTIME: The first two (2) hours before or after eight (8) regular hours Monday through Friday and the first eight (8) hours on Saturday shall be paid at one and one-half times the hourly rate of pay. All other hours worked Monday through Saturday, and all hours worked on Sundays and Holidays shall be paid at double the straight time rate of pay. On a Four Tens (4-10's) weekly schedule, either Monday thru Thursday or Tuesday thru Friday, all hours worked before or after the normal shift shall be paid at double the straight time rate of pay. The Monday or Friday not utilized in the normal Four-Ten's work week, and Saturday shall be paid at one and one half (1-1/2) times the regular shift rate for the first eight (8) hours. All other hours worked Monday through Saturday, and all hours worked on Sundays and Holidays shall be paid at double the straight time rate of pay.

HOLIDAYS: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, the Friday after Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day (8). Any holiday which falls on a Sunday shall be observed as a holiday on the following Monday. Any holiday which falls on a Saturday shall be observed as a holiday on the preceding Friday.
